## **General Information & Conditions**

#### Aims of the Society

To promote and publicise the Shire Horse

As shire horse enthusiasts we would like to see an increase in the numbers of purebred shires and an increase in their use for ploughing, riding and showing.

The aim is not just to breed shires but to breed good quality, healthy animals. Shire horses are gentle giants and make great all round horses turning their hooves to many different disciplines, there are shire horses competing all over the country under saddle, in harness and in hand.

Once you have befriended these beautiful animals you will be as passionate about them as we are.

Did you know Shire horses were used at both world wars, pulling heavy artillery?



## The Shire Horse Society Silver Spoon is awarded to the Best Mare or Filly and Best Stallion at the Show. Conditions of these Awards are as follows:

- 1. A Spoon and Rosette to the Best Mare or Filly.
- 2. The winner of the Special Prize must be a member of the Shire Horse Society.
- 3. Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in Classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has been either suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
- 4. No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year. The Royal and Shire Horse Society Shows being excluded.
- 5. THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.
- 6. The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the Award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.

The Council reserves the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society.

#### Rules

- 1. The Judge's decision is final.
- 2. Steward's instructions must be obeyed.
- 3. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
- 4. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
- 5. All exhibitors must have liability insurance.
- 6. Horses are not allowed in the spectator area of the Show Field.
- 7. Exhibitors may enter a horse in only once in-hand (affiliated) class.
